Christchurch seasonal service returns





Special Seating Flexibilities



The following passenger categories will receive a seat assignment without charge on an Economy Class Light regardless of booking class.

- 1. Cathay members (Gold or above)
- 2. Oneworld members (Sapphire or above)
- 3. Passengers with Infant (INF,INS) or Child (CHD) in the same booking
- 4. Passengers with confirmed special assistance services (SSR) in the booking

This means that once bookings are ticketed you will be able to pre-select seating for your high tier frequent flyers, families and passengers requiring extra assistance.

Hong Kong in-town check in opens



We are pleased to announce that from 5 July 2023 we resumed in-town check in services at Hong Kong Airport Express Station. Cathay Pacific is the first airline to relaunch services outside of the airport after a three year suspension.

This service allows passengers to check in and bag-drop up to 90 minutes before flight departure, prior to arriving at the airport and to enjoy a seamless and stress-free boarding experience.

The in-town check in facilities at Hong Kong Station will be available every day from **6.00am to 3.00pm** in this introductory phase.

Sustainability Corner



Achieving further waste reduction is always a focus at Cathay Pacific. In our Economy Class cabin team have explored alternative materials and reviewed service procedures whilst also ensuring the passenger experience is not compromised.

We have introduced new drinking cups that are sustainable and can serve both hot and cold beverages. We found a product that is paper based and comprises of less than 1% plastic, which certifies as Flustix material with the ability to be recycled.

Plastic cutlery has been replaced with the use of modified stainless steel cutlery, which has seen a positive impact on customer satisfaction with an elevated dining experience provided to passengers.

The lids on the side dishes have been made reusable dental floss replaced with wooden toothpicks, styrofoam dry ice containers replaced with cooler bags and plastic straws removed from the inflight experience.
