EARNING MILES AND CLUB POINTS



Asia Miles and Marco Polo Club members will earn the same Asia Miles and club points on Auckland-Hong Kong or Christchurch-Hong Kong services operated by Air New Zealand (when on a CX flight number), as they would on a service operated by Cathay Pacific.

** Airpoints Gold and Elite passengers will have access to Cathay Pacific's lounges at Hong Kong International Airport when waiting to board the flight from Hong Kong to Auckland, but not while transiting from an Auckland - Hong Kong flight to another flight operated by Cathay Pacific (unless they are traveling in Business Class on the second leg). The exception being if the passenger is connecting to a flight to Beijing or Shanghai operated by Cathay Pacific or Cathay Dragon. Oneworld member benefits such as; Lounge Entry and Additional Baggage, will not apply for passengers traveling in Economy or Premium Economy on a CX flight number operated by Air New Zealand aircraft between Auckland - Hong Kong - Auckland.
